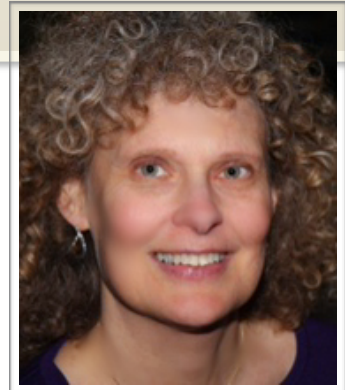


Emotionally Focused Therapy 4 day Externship

Gail has her Masters in Social Work, is a Registered Marriage and Family Therapist in Canada and an Approved Supervisor with the American Association of Marriage and Family Therapy. She is a couple and family therapy lecturer at the School of Social Work at Carleton University and St. Paul's University in Ottawa. Gail trains therapists in Canada, USA, England and The Netherlands.
